


COMPARISON TABLE FOR INTENSIVE ENGLISH WITH CONTINUING EDUCATION VS. ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES

<i>Questions to ask prospective students</i>	<i>Non-credit Intensive English Continuing Ed</i>	<i>English for Academic Purposes (EAP) with MDC credit courses</i>
<i>Are you an international student under visa status?</i>	No. You can take non-credit classes with Continuing Education.	Yes. If you answered yes, you must see an International Advisor 
<i>Are you a Florida resident (one year in Florida)?</i>	No. You can take advantage of the tuition rate of \$299 per class for 6 levels with Continuing Education.	Yes. You can apply for the lower tuition rate of \$118.22 per credit for a total of \$1,655.08 for 14 credits for levels 1 to 4 and \$1,418.64 for 12 credits for levels 4 to 6 depending on the ACCUPLACER test results.
<i>Do you have your high school diploma translated?</i>	No. You do not need your high school diploma to take Intensive English classes with Continuing Education.	Yes. You must present proof of your HS duly translated and approved by the MDC Admissions Department, which is the basis of Admissions to College to take EAP credit courses.
<i>Have you been properly admitted to MDC?</i>	No. You need to come in person to Room 1112 at the West Campus to take a placement exam prior to registering.	No. The Admissions and/or readmission process for MDC is online at https://my.mdc.edu/ or you may visit us in person in the MDC Admissions area Room 2108 at West Campus. After a year "hiatus", you must reapply again.
<i>Are you transferring from another institution?</i>	No. You need to come in person to Room 1112 at the West Campus to take a placement exam prior to registering.	Yes. You must go to Admissions to complete the process of a smooth transition or apply online at https://www.collegetransfer.net/Plan-My-Transfer/institutionId/1002
<i>Have you applied for Financial Aid?</i>	Financial aid does not cover the non-credit classes.	Go to https://www.mdc.edu/financialaid/ You must have your HS diploma on file with MDC in order to qualify for F.A. with us.
<i>Do you have financial aid?</i>	No. You need to pay out of pocket for your class tuition.	Yes. You may use your Financial Aid including scholarships to pay for your EAP courses.
<i>Do you have other payment plans like, Nelnet?</i>	No. You cannot use Nelnet to pay for non-credit classes.	Yes. You may use Nelnet to pay for your EAP courses even if you do not have F.A. or if you are waiting for the adjudication of the funding from F.A. for the current term.
<i>Have you taken the test with the Testing Department?</i>	No. You need to come in person to Room 1112 at the West Campus to take a placement exam prior to registering.	No. Go to the testing department online website at https://www.mdc.edu/main/testing/criteria/eap.aspx for more information and take the ACCUPLACER test in person prior to registration in the corresponding EAP courses depending on the results of the test.
<i>Are you ready to see your Continuing Education advisor?</i>	Yes. Go in person to Room 1112 West Campus in order to register.	Not Applicable.
<i>Are you ready to see your EAP advisor?</i>	Not Applicable	Yes. You may go to Academic Affairs in room 1218 at West Campus and ask to see the EAP Advisor or make an appointment online at https://www.picktime.com/eap
