Verbs define action and can be irregular or regular. These forms are the infinitive, simple present, simple past, past participle, and present participle. The difference between a **regular** and an **irregular verb** is the formation of the simple past and past participle. **Regular verbs** are dependably consistent—the simple past ends in ed as does the past participle. <u>Keep a notebook just for verbs adding verbs that you</u> <u>need to know to this list.</u>
